MEMORANDUM FOR Parks Reserve Force Training Area Personnel, Tenant Units, Training Units and Visitors.

SUBJECT: PRFTA Policy # 22, Privately Owned Weapons regulations for the United States Army Garrison, Parks RFTA Installation.

1. REFERENCES.

2. PURPOSE. To establish privately owned weapons regulations for United States Army Garrison, Parks RFTA and to prescribe the responsibility of all weapons possession on the installation.

3. APPLICABILITY. This regulation applies to all units, staff, directorates, civilians, activities and anyone else while on property owned, leased or otherwise under the control of the United States Army Garrison, Parks Reserve Force Training Area, California.

4. POLICY: The Garrison Commander permits certain entry of privately owned weapons onto Parks RFTA installation. In any case not covered by this policy, the laws of the State of California, United States Code or Code of Federal Regulations will apply. Upon entering this military installation, a person subjects themselves and their vehicles to search and inspections by the Department of the Army Civilian Police (DACP), and/or the Department of the Army Security Guard (DASG) and/or Military Police.

a. Personnel must register **ALL** firearms brought on the Installation with the Parks RFTA Police Department. Firearms must be registered regardless of military or civilian status. Call the Parks RFTA Police Department at (925) 875-4720 / 4721, building 790 for more information about the registration procedures, or acquire the registration form. This requirement applies regardless of personnel category (Military, Family member, Guest, Unaffiliated Civilian, DoD Civilian, Retirees, etc).

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b. Active Sworn local, state or federal law enforcement officers on Parks RFTA during the course of their regular duty or on official business are exempt from this requirement. Such officers will present their credentials and reason for being on post at the ACP unless responding to an emergency call for assistance on Parks RFTA in a marked police vehicle.

c. All classes of person shall register their firearms in accordance with the timeline below. DoD Civilians, Assigned Military Members and Military Retirees registration will be valid for five (5) years.

(1) Persons residing in Government Quarters must register privately owned firearms within 72 hours of arriving at the installation.

(2) All other persons must register privately owned firearms prior to arriving on the installation.

(3) Civilians and Soldiers not assigned, attached, or temporarily stationed at Parks RFTA will register their firearm(s) with the Parks RFTA Police Department prior to bringing the firearm onto the Installation. Civilian registrations will be valid for twelve (12) months.

d. Process to register firearms:

(1) Complete a legible FHL/PRFTA form 8-1 (FHL/PRFTA Weapons Registration).

(2) The form can be obtained and registration process completed at Parks RFTA Police Department.

(3) Maintain a copy of the signed approved weapon registration at all times when transporting a weapon on the installation.

(4) Personnel must declare any firearm they are carrying/transporting if and when stopped at the Access Control Points (ACPs), when being inspected by ACP personnel, when inspected at any other checkpoint on the installation, when stopped for random inspection or when stopped by Department of the Army Civilian Police or Department of the Army Security Guard Force.

(5) Prohibited Possession:

a. Any person convicted of a felony.

b. Any person convicted of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence (Lautenberg Amendment).

c. Any person who is a fugitive from justice.

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d. Any person who has been convicted in any court for the possession, use, or sale of Marijuana, or dangerous drug, or narcotic drug, to include non-judicial punishment under Article 15 UCMJ.

e. Any person who is declared mentally incompetent.

f. Any person restrained by an Order of Protection, Injunction Against Harassment or other legal court document prohibiting possession.

(6) The Parks RFTA/FHL Directorate of Emergency Services (DES) will:

a. Maintain the database of all registered firearms utilizing the Centralized Operations Police Suite (COPS) System.

b. Respond to all reported violations of this regulation.

c. Screen all privately owned firearms registration requests through NCIC.

d. Register privately owned firearms with proper security checks and approval.

e. Instruct Access Control Personnel to assist all personnel who declare possession of unregistered to register the firearms.

e. Persons transporting a Privately Owned Firearm (POF) on Parks RFTA must enter through an Access Control Point (ACP), declare that they are bringing a POF on the Installation and state the reason they are doing so to ACP personnel. Personnel must also declare possession of firearms to officials upon being directed to an ACP inspection area, being stopped by law enforcement officials, or for any other checkpoint or inspection operation.

(1) Weapons can only be carried in a vehicle when travelling to and from authorized hunting, marksmanship events, coming from/to a firearms vendor/event, target practice at off post locations.

(2) Weapons must be secured in the vehicles trunk, if the vehicle doesn't have a lockable trunk, they must be encased in such a manner that it is not readily accessible to the driver or any passenger.

(3) Weapons must be transported unloaded and all ammunition must be stored separately from the weapon.

(4) Weapons may not be carried concealed on any person. (Concealed weapons permits are not valid on FHL or PRFTA).

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f. Fireworks (Pyrotechnic devices), any type of explosive device or any other weapon or explosive prohibited by federal law are prohibited to be possessed or used on the Installation, except for official use as approved/designated by the Installation Commander.

g. Every applicable provision of the policy is enforceable by the Parks RFTA Police Department. Violating this policy within the Parks RFTA Jurisdiction is subject to disciplinary action under the Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ), Administration Action under the Table of Penalties of AR 690-700, Chapter 751 for DOD Civilians and other applicable laws and regulations.

5. PROPONENT. The Director of Emergency Services is the proponent for this policy. POC for this action is the PRFTA Police Department Chief at (925) 875-4720.

DISCLOSURE: Disclosure of the information is voluntary, however, failure to provide the information may result in not being allowed to register personal firearms.
